<p>The server in this scenario was running with the following names: [Gonzo.local, localhost, 127.0.0.1, 10.0.1.2]</p> <p>Selecting from a remote client using RMI graph names was successful:</p> <pre>select \$s \$p \$o from <rmi://Gonzo.local/server1#>; [rmi://10.0.1.2/server1#, http:www.w3.org/1999/02/22-rdf-syntax-ns#type, http://mulgara.org/mulgara#Model] 1 rows returned</pre> <p>However, creating a graph using this host name failed:</p> <pre>create <rmi://gonzo.local/server1#data> Error: Could not commit creation of model rmi://gonzo.local/server1#data of type http://mulgara.org/mulgara#Model</pre> <p>Was the problem due to the upper case "G"?</p> <pre>create <rmi://gonzo.local/server1#data> Error: Could not commit creation of model rmi://Gonzo.local/server1#data of type http://mulgara.org/mulgara#Model</pre> <p>But using the IP works:</p> <pre>create <rmi://10.0.1.2/server1#data> Successfully created graph rmi://10.0.1.2/server1#data</pre> <p>(Also note the inconsistent use of "graph" and "model". This should be addressed)</p>
